Overall, applications are up by 2.4 percent on weighted absolute basis for 731 programs worldwide responding to both 2019 and 2020 surveys.




Overall, 67 percent of 1,042 programs worldwide responding to the 2020 survey report an relative increase in application volumes.

Percentage of Programs Reporting Growth in Applications: Relative Change in Total Applications by Region














United States: Relative Year-on-Year Change in Total Applications

Recruitment

- 66% reduced travel budget
- 49% sought to recruit more domestic candidates

Admissions

- 61% allowed students to defer entry
- 59% extended application deadlines

Program

- 53% offered online start with in-person transition
- 25% started all students in the fall semester online
