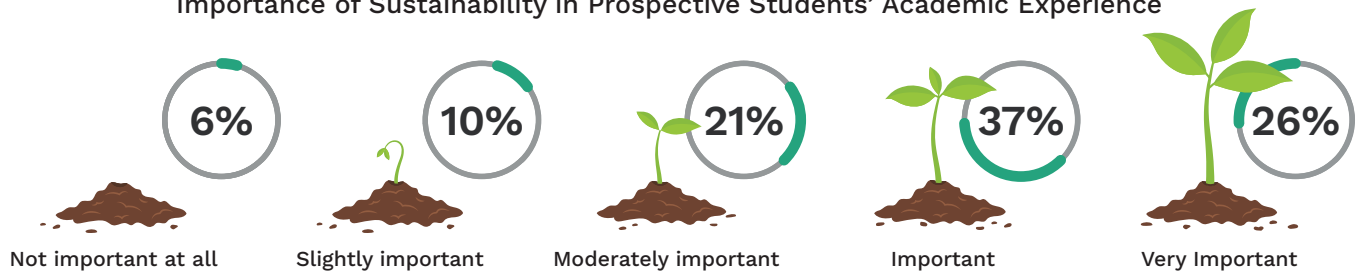


Prospective Business Students and Sustainability

Nearly all candidates say sustainability has at least some importance to their academic experience.

Importance of Sustainability in Prospective Students' Academic Experience



We asked prospective students who said sustainability is important to their business school experience if they would rule out applying to a school that does not prioritize the topic — and many said yes.

34%

of sustainability-concerned candidates would **rule out** applying to a school that does not prioritize the topic

Most candidates also say an employer's sustainable and ethical practices would impact their decision to accept a job.
