

Regional Profile | Middle East

From 2021 to 2022, total hiring increased for MBA graduates and direct-from-industry talent in the Middle East.

Total hiring for most GME graduates and candidates with bachelor's degrees decreased from 2021 to 2022 in the Middle East.





In the Middle East, many employers anticipate more demand for hiring GME graduates in the next five years.


No employers believe demand for hiring will decline.

The error bars represent the 95 percent confidence intervals for each estimated population proportion. When the error bars do not overlap between groups, this indicates a significant difference.
